12 enjoyed golf, hunting, fishing, and tending the livestock and other
13 animals on his ranch; in addition, he and his wife, Judy Stoepel,
14 raised a fine family and shared 65 years of marriage before she

16 WHEREAS, Held in the highest regard by all who knew him, Ken
17 Stoepel dedicated himself to bettering his adopted hometown, and
18 his rich legacy of civic activism continues to inspire his fellow
