2 servant with the tragic passing of Officer Andrew Albert Esparza in
3 the line of duty on April 13, 2007, at the age of 26, while coming to
4 the aid of a fellow officer; and

5 WHEREAS, A lifelong resident of North Texas, Andrew Esparza
6 was born in Fort Worth on April 29, 1980, and graduated from
7 Burleson High School in 1998; he earned degrees in business
8 marketing and Spanish from The University of Texas at Arlington and
9 followed in his brother's footsteps when he joined the Irving
10 Police Department in 2005; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Esparza's expertise and professionalism
12 belied his age and earned him the respect and admiration of his
13 peers; chosen to serve on the department's SWAT team, he was known
14 for his desire to help others and was always eager to lend a hand to
15 individuals in need; and

16 WHEREAS, In his free time, this active and vibrant young
17 Texan enjoyed hunting, fishing, baseball, softball, and rock
18 climbing; above all else, he cherished his faith and family; and

19 WHEREAS, Andrew Esparza built a life that was filled with
20 accomplishments and meaningful service, and those who were
21 privileged to know him will forever carry him close in their hearts;
22 now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
24 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Officer Andrew Albert

1 Esparza and extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to
