R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Angelina McGough has shown great initiative and  
2 school spirit by serving on the student council for Treetops  
3 Intermediate School in Euless; and

4 WHEREAS, The fifth- and sixth-grade students who serve on the  
5 council devote several hours each month to important projects that  
6 help their schoolmates and other residents of their community; with  
7 the assistance of council advisor Marci Clanton-Meyer and Treetops  
8 director Lou Blanchard, these responsible young Texans are doing  
9 their part to improve the world around them while learning  
10 important lessons about civic involvement; and

11 WHEREAS, A member of the Treetops Intermediate School Student  
12 Council for two years, Ms. McGough has served as the council public  
13 relations officer during this period; her duties include making  
14 posters that remind members of meetings and that publicize events  
15 of interest to the entire school; she has participated in a variety  
16 of council projects, including a literacy program to assist younger  
17 students and a group effort to adopt a nursing home and has led  
18 campus tours for visitors and welcomed new students to Treetops;  
19 she also helped plan Red Ribbon Week, part of a national program  
20 that allows students to learn the dangers of drugs and alcohol, and  
21 contributed to the creation of a mural that illustrates the "I Have  
22 A Dream" speech by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

23 WHEREAS, Ms. McGough has also been involved in council  
24 activities that support the U.S. troops serving overseas, including

1 Operation Valentine and Flags Across America; for these projects,  
2 she created valentine cards and hand-drawn flags that contained  
3 messages for active-duty military personnel; moreover, she was  
4 involved in the Veteran's Day project that recognized family  
5 members for their military service by including their names on a  
6 wall of honor in the classroom, and she was part of a welcome party  
7 for returning soldiers at the Dallas/Fort Worth International  
8 Airport; in total, she has logged more than 50 hours of work as a  
9 student council volunteer; and

10 WHEREAS, Committed to bettering her school and community,  
11 Angelina McGough has played an important role in student council  
12 activities, and her dedication and hard work indeed merit special  
13 recognition; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
15 Legislature hereby honor Angelina McGough for her service on the  
16 Treetops Intermediate School Student Council and extend to her best  
17 wishes for continued achievement as a student and citizen; and, be
