12 Chamber of Commerce and the Lufkin High School Alumni Association;  
13 an active congregant of First United Methodist Church, he was  
14 active in the Fellowship Sunday School Class and served as church  
15 council chair; and

16           WHEREAS, He and his wife, the late Joanne Hallmark, were the  
17 parents of four beloved children; in 1990, after the loss of their  
18 eldest son, Kenzy D. Hallmark, Jr., the couple established a  
19 memorial scholarship in his name at Texas A&M University; and

20           WHEREAS, Kenzy Hallmark lived a caring and purposeful life,  
21 and he leaves behind a legacy to treasure for those who held him  
22 dear; now, therefore, be it
