1 WHEREAS, The LBJ High School theater is being dedicated in 2 honor of Don T. Haynes, Jr., the institution's director of bands for 3 32 years; and

WHEREAS, A musician from the age of six, Mr. Haynes grew up playing the piano, trumpet, French horn, flute, clarinet, and cello under the guidance of his father, a high school band director, and his mother, a trained vocalist; he continued to pursue his passion in college, earning bachelor's and master's degrees from The University of Texas, where he was a member of the Longhorn Marching Band; and

11 WHEREAS, After two years as the assistant band director at 12 Anderson High School, he was named the director of the LBJ High School Band in 1975; with Mr. Haynes at the helm, the program has 13 14 earned first place recognition in five states and consistently won Division I and sweepstakes honors at UIL marching and concert 15 performances; Jaguar Band members have also represented the United 16 States in the 1996 New Year's Day Parade in London, played concerts 17 18 in England, toured France, and served as ambassadors of music in Beijing, China; and 19

20 WHEREAS, This notable director's drive and determination 21 have been a galvanizing force for his students, and their many 22 successes have been attributable, in part, to his ability to hone 23 and encourage their talents; and

1 City Marching Festival as a joint project of the band parent groups at LBJ and Crockett High Schools; he has also shared his time and 2 talents with a number of professional organizations, holding 3 4 leadership positions with the Texas Music Educators Association and 5 serving on the TMEA Advisory Board, the UIL State Sight-reading 6 Advisory Committee, and the executive board of directors for the 7 Texas Bandmasters Association, and as a member of the Phi Beta Mu 8 band director fraternity; and

9 WHEREAS, His contributions have earned him a number of 10 accolades throughout his career; named Teacher of the Year four 11 times by his colleagues at LBJ High School, he was presented with 12 the statewide Denius Award in 1994 for his achievements as a UIL 13 sponsor, and has been invited to conduct region bands in Texas, New 14 Mexico, Louisiana, and Florida; and

WHEREAS, Don Haynes has long been a source of tremendous pride for the LBJ High School community, and the naming of the school's theater in his honor will ensure that his legacy will continue to inspire students for years to come; now, therefore, be it
