1 WHEREAS, Dr. Bloyce H. Britton of San Antonio is rendering
2 exceptional service to his community in both the professional and
3 civic arenas; and

4 WHEREAS, After earning degrees from Wake Forest University,
5 The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, and
6 the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Dr. Britton
7 returned to San Antonio to teach part-time at the dental school and
8 to practice orthodontics; in addition to maintaining the private
9 practice he established in 1997, he continues to serve on the
10 faculty at the health science center and also holds an adjunct
11 position on the dental faculty at UNC; and

12 WHEREAS, For many years, Dr. Britton has devoted untold hours
13 in a volunteer capacity to helping conduct the GOLD Youth
14 Leadership Development Program; geared to high school sophomores
15 who have shown impressive leadership qualities, the program
16 encourages participants to contribute to their schools and
17 communities and provides them with skills that will assist them in
18 accomplishing their goals; thanks in large measure to the dedicated
19 efforts of Dr. Britton, whose work in behalf of the program has
20 included service as chairman of the board, approximately 300
21 students from as many schools throughout South and Central Texas
22 are able each year to attend the organization's outstanding
23 four-day training session; and

24 WHEREAS, Dr. Britton also plays an active role in the GOLD

1 Optimist Club of San Antonio, and he has given generous support to
2 the Friends of the Bulverde/Spring Branch Library; and

3 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Dr. Britton is the husband of
4 Edie Britton and the father of two sons, Hill and Spencer; and

5 WHEREAS, Held in the highest esteem by all who have the good
6 fortune to know this accomplished and public-spirited Texan, Dr.
7 Bloyce Britton is committed to making a positive difference in the
8 lives of his neighbors and fellow citizens, and it is indeed
