1 WHEREAS, Del Rio firefighter Jason Ford is the recipient of
2 the 2006 Medal of Merit from the Del Rio Fire and Rescue Department,
3 and it is a pleasure to honor him for his service to the Del Rio
4 community; and

5 WHEREAS, Specifically recognized for his active community
6 involvement, Officer Ford has led numerous fund-raisers to benefit
7 a variety of charitable endeavors; during a fire/police softball
8 tournament in November 2006, he raised more than \$1,600 for the
