WHEREAS, Born in Acapulco, Jose Martinez came to the United States at the age of 12 and attended school in Connecticut; after graduating from Woodstock Academy, he joined the United States Air Force; and

WHEREAS, During his distinguished 26-year career in the Air 8 9 Force, Master Sergeant Martinez received numerous decorations, including the Meritorious Service Medal, two Air Force Commendation 10 11 Medals, the Air Force Longevity Service Ribbon with five devices, 12 and the Vietnam Service Medal with one device, among others; he was 13 also recognized as the Southern Communication Area Airman of the 14 Year and the Southern Command Area Outstanding Air Force Executive Support Superintendent of the Year; and 15

16 WHEREAS, Master Sergeant Martinez was also active in civic 17 affairs on base, volunteering for the Joseph P. Kennedy Olympic 18 Marathon and serving as a translator for the church; he likewise 19 served on the Base Advisory, Chaplain Fund, Social Action, and Base 20 Support Councils; and

21 WHEREAS, Even as he was serving his country with such 22 distinction, Master Sergeant Martinez contributed greatly to his 23 community; stationed at Laughlin Air Force Base near Del Rio since 24 1973, he was a member of the San Felipe Lions Club and the Border

Federal Credit Union Credit Committee; in addition, he was active in the Brown Plaza Association, promoting Mexican culture, HAND, which assisted senior citizens with home repair, and he was a co-founder of the women's softball team and the youth soccer team; and

6 WHEREAS, In the years since his retirement from the Air Force 7 1981, Master Sergeant Martinez has been leader in а in 8 organizations that support veterans and the military; a member of the Air Force Sergeants Association and the Non-Commissioned 9 10 Officers Association, he has also acted as a judge advocate for the Veterans of Foreign Wars and as a vice-commander in the American 11 12 Legion; and

WHEREAS, In his role as first vice-commander of the American 13 14 GI Forum, Master Sergeant Martinez has been instrumental in efforts 15 to maintain that organization's Wall of Honor, where pictures of deceased veterans from Del Rio and Val Verde County are displayed; 16 17 moreover, he has contributed greatly to the efforts of Operation Troop Family Support, which welcomes home all military personnel 18 returning from war zones, and he has served as chair of the Veterans 19 Day Parade and co-chair of the Del Rio Fourth of July parade; his 20 21 dedication to the community of Del Rio was recognized in 2000 with an Appreciation Award presented by the mayor; and 22

23 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Jose Martinez has enjoyed the 24 support of his loving wife, his five children, and seven 25 grandchildren; his family tradition of service to the country 26 continued with the enlistment of three of his sons in the Air Force; 27 and
