R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The retirement of Captain Clifton H. Grumbles of San
2 Antonio from the Texas Department of Public Safety on April 30,
3 2007, brings to a close an exceptional career in public service that
4 has spanned nearly four decades; and

5 WHEREAS, A valued member of the department, Captain Grumbles
6 has most recently served as manager of the DPS Private Security
7 Bureau and he brought to that post a wealth of experience gained
8 over the course of his outstanding tenure in the field of law
9 enforcement; and

10 WHEREAS, Captain Grumbles began his service in 1969 with the
11 Bexar County Sheriff's Office; he later worked for the San Marcos
12 Police Department and for the Windcrest Police Department, where he
13 was employed for 17 years and was named chief of police; and

15 an investigator in 1989, Captain Grumbles was named chief of
16 investigations in 1998; earning subsequent promotions as the
17 commission's deputy director and executive director, he accepted
18 his current position as bureau manager in 2004; and

19 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Cliff Grumbles enjoys the
20 love and support of his wife of 36 years, Linda, their two children,
21 Clint and Jenny, and their three grandchildren; and

22 WHEREAS, Captain Grumbles has earned the lasting respect of
23 all who have been privileged to work with him through the years, and
24 he may indeed reflect with justifiable pride on his many

1 contributions to the safety and welfare of his fellow Texans; now,
2 therefore, be it
