1 WHEREAS, The students of the Van High School drama
2 department, under the direction of drama teacher Larry Wisdom, have
3 earned the right to perform their production of *Man of La Mancha* at
4 the UIL State Meet One-Act Play Contest; and

5 WHEREAS, This significant accomplishment marks the school's
6 fourth appearance at the state-level contest in the past six years
7 and represents Mr. Wisdom's 21st time as a director at a state meet;
8 the Van ensemble placed third in 2004 with the play *Assassins*, and
9 their 2002 and 2005 productions of *Godspell* and *The Caucasian Chalk*
10 *Circle* each earned first-place honors; and

11 WHEREAS, In addition to their achievements in UIL, the
12 members of the Van drama department have also distinguished
13 themselves in the National Forensics League; in the past three
14 years, 10 Van students have qualified for the organization's
15 national tournament, five of whom will be vying in the 2007
16 competition; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Wisdom and his troupe of young Texans have
18 demonstrated the importance of hard work and dedication in
19 achieving success; they are a tremendous source of pride to their
20 families, school, and community, and it is a pleasure to recognize
21 them; now, therefore, be it
