## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Born in New York on May 10, 1932, Dr. Austin spent his formative years in the Bronx, where he enjoyed playing basketball with his friends; he earned a bachelor of arts degree from Grinnell College in Iowa before serving in the U.S. Air Force for three years, after which he pursued a graduate degree in biology at Boston College; and

10 WHEREAS, In 1963, Dr. Austin received his doctorate in 11 medicine from Meharry Medical College in Nashville, Tennessee; he 12 did his pediatric residency at Upstate Medical Center of the State 13 University of New York and earned a fellowship in hematology from 14 Tufts University; and

WHEREAS, A noted pediatrician and children's health 15 advocate, Dr. Austin has more than 43 years of experience in the 16 field of pediatrics; currently serving as a consultant advisor for 17 18 community development at the Cullen Child and Adolescent Health Center, Dr. Austin was the center's director of community 19 development for a number of years and played a key role in its 20 21 establishment; he has also served as an assistant clinical professor of pediatrics at Baylor College of Medicine; and 22

23 WHEREAS, For his work as an advocate for children's health 24 and education, Dr. Austin received an honorary doctorate in humane

letters from Grinnell College, where he was recently elected to the school's board of trustees; he is also a recipient of the Savvy Award, recipients of which are nominated by the Child Abuse Prevention Network, and he was honored in May 2006 with the dedication of the R.
