3     Rio Police Department in May 2000; and

5     Texas in 1958 as a member of the United States Air Force stationed

7     and the couple were married in that city and lived there until his  
8     discharge in 1960, when they relocated to Chicago; and

10    and raised their three children in that southwestern Texas city;  
11    Mr. Romanelli takes great pride in his close-knit family that now  
12    includes five beloved grandchildren; and

14    force, Tom Romanelli's record was one of meritorious service,  
15    loyalty, personal bravery, and self-sacrifice consistent with the  
16    highest ideals of the law enforcement profession, and it is most  
17    appropriate to take the opportunity presented by his retirement to  
18    join the many people he has aided over the last three decades in  
19    thanking him for an outstanding career in public service; now,
