R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot express the heartache felt at the loss
2 of Army Captain Sean Lyerly of Pflugerville, who was killed in Iraq
3 on January 20, 2007, at the age of 31; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Lafayette, Louisiana, Captain Lyerly grew up
5 in Houston and graduated from Stratford High School in 1994; he
6 developed a love of plants while visiting Brazil and went on to earn
7 a degree in horticulture at Texas A&M University; and

8 WHEREAS, Captain Lyerly followed in the footsteps of his
9 father and other close family members when he joined the military in
10 1996; he enlisted in the Texas Army National Guard, completing
11 advanced individual training as a cannon crewmember before
12 enrolling in the Reserve Officers' Training Corps at A&M; and

13 WHEREAS, After completing the U.S. Army Aviation Officer
14 Basic Course and the UH-60 Aviator Qualification Course, he was
15 promoted to captain; generous and compassionate, he volunteered to
16 fly support missions in Texas and Louisiana in the aftermaths of
17 Hurricanes Katrina and Rita; and

18 WHEREAS, Our state and nation are fortunate to have men and
19 women whose love for their country inspires them to take up military
20 service, yet the tragic death of this fine young man is a sobering
21 reminder of the cost of war; Captain Lyerly embodied the highest
22 ideals of the U.S. armed forces, and those who knew and loved him
23 will forever carry him close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas

1 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Sean Lyerly and extend
2 deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife, Csilla
3 Lyerly; to his son, Zackary Lyerly; to his mother, Deborah
4 Russo-Blakeman and her husband, John; to his father, George Edward
5 Lyerly and his wife, Monica; to his brother, George Edward Lyerly,
6 Jr.; to his grandmothers, Virginia Lyerly and Elvina Rachal Russo;
7 to his godfather, Louis Russo; and to his other relatives and many
