

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The passing of William Howard Dickerson of Baytown  
2 on March 29, 2007, at the age of 82, deeply saddened the family and  
3 friends of this beloved gentleman; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Blacksburg, Virginia, on January 10, 1925,  
5 Mr. Dickerson joined the U.S. Navy in May 1942 and served in the  
6 Pacific campaign during the Second World War; he was discharged  
7 from active duty in May 1949; and

8           WHEREAS, Mr. Dickerson earned his bachelor of science degree  
9 in chemical engineering from Virginia Polytechnic Institute; he  
10 retired from Lubrizol in April 1991 and subsequently became active  
11 in the Lubrizol Retiree Group; and

12           WHEREAS, A loving husband and devoted father, Mr. Dickerson  
13 married Minetta Charlton Dickerson on April 10, 1948, and during  
14 their 59 years together they raised a fine family; and

15           WHEREAS, William Howard Dickerson was a valued congregant of  
16 the First Christian Church of Baytown, where he was elected elder  
17 emeritus in 1998; he also served on the board of the YMCA and  
18 received awards for his work with the GAP Bicycle Program; in  
19 addition, he gave generously of his time and talents to the Optimist  
20 Club and Kiwanis, and for his philanthropic contributions to the  
21 latter group he earned designation as a George F. Hixson Fellow; and

22           WHEREAS, Although his death has brought great sorrow to his  
23 loved ones, William Dickerson lived a caring and purposeful life,  
24 and he leaves behind a legacy to be treasured by those who held him

2           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
3 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of William Howard  
4 Dickerson and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family:
