2 members Sara Stephens and Brian Rubaie have ably represented their
3 team and their university at the 61st annual National Debate
4 Tournament in Dallas from March 30 to April 2, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, Established in 1999, the UT Dallas Debate Team has
6 grown from a regional competitor to a national one; the team offers
7 four full scholarships each year and top team members travel from
8 five to seven weekends each semester, competing at tournaments from
9 late September to early April; and

11 Director Chris Burk and Assistant Director and Coach Scott Herndon,
12 Ms. Stephens, a junior from Pensacola, Florida, and Mr. Rubaie, a
