5 WHEREAS, Air Interdiction Agent Thrasher lost his life while 6 providing air support to border patrol agents conducting ground 7 operations in Brooks County; and

8 WHEREAS, Born on February 9, 1975, in Henderson, Clinton 9 Thrasher had been enchanted with flying since his youth; he earned 10 his pilot's license before graduating from Henderson High School 11 and went on to attend Louisiana Tech University, where he received a 12 bachelor's degree in aviation; and

WHEREAS, Agent Thrasher graduated in 1997 from the Border 13 14 Patrol Academy and served for a time in Rio Grande City; in 2003, he joined the CBP Air and Marine and was stationed at the Caribbean Air 15 Branch in Aguadilla, Puerto Rico; he returned stateside in 2006, 16 transferring to the McAllen Air Unit; known for his commitment to 17 18 the mission, he spoke often of his love for his profession, which combined his passion for flying with his dedication to law 19 enforcement; and 20

21 WHEREAS, A devoted and loving husband, Agent Thrasher enjoyed 22 nine years of marriage to his wife, Rachelle, and he delighted in 23 his role as father to their two daughters, Addalyn and AnnMarie; 24 moreover, he was a thoughtful and caring friend to many; and
