R E S O L U T I O N

2 at the tragic death of Alexander Erikson Fleming of Whitehouse, who
3 passed away on May 8, 2007, at the age of 17; and

4 WHEREAS, Born December 4, 1989, in Bedford, Alex Fleming was
5 a junior at Whitehouse High School, where he was respected and
6 admired by students and teachers alike for his numerous
7 achievements; a member of the National Honor Society, he was a
8 varsity football and track letterman and he played for the junior
9 varsity baseball team; moreover, he distinguished himself through
10 his involvement in the Whitehouse High School Band and the school's
11 Jazz Band, and he was a UIL state qualifier in solo and ensemble
12 competition; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Fleming shared his time with several community
14 organizations, including the Good Samaritan Outreach Center, the
15 Salvation Army, and PATH (People Attempting to Help), and he was a
16 member of Green Acres Baptist Church, which he served as a summer
17 camp volunteer; he also provided car detailing and lawn maintenance
18 services through his own business, Alex At Your Service; and

19 WHEREAS, Although his time on this earth was far too brief,
20 Alex Fleming impressed countless people with his leadership, his
21 integrity, and his many talents, and memories of time spent in his
22 company will be forever cherished by all those who knew and loved
23 him; now, therefore, be it
