WHEREAS, Ms. Quiram began her employment at American Amicable on February 8, 1951, as a messenger/mail clerk, and her career has seen steady advancement over the course of more than five decades; after being promoted to file clerk, she went on to work in the accounting and data processing departments before accepting a position in special projects; and

WHEREAS, This esteemed woman served as executive secretary to senior vice president of finance Thomas B. - 9 Cosmetology Commission after her appointment by Texas Governor
- 10 George W. Bush; moreover, the Texas Federation of Republican Women
- 11 honored her with the special TFRW Tribute to Women Recognition, and
- 12 she was the cochair of the largest TFRW State Convention in the
