R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, United States Air Force Staff Sergeant Glenn A.  
2 Wright has been awarded the Bronze Star for his meritorious service  
3 in Iraq; and

4           WHEREAS, Working as an explosive ordnance disposal team  
5 leader, Staff Sergeant Wright led more than 50 operations from  
6 September 2005 to January 2006, helping to excavate, recover, and  
7 destroy weapons and firearms caches that totaled more than 3,500  
8 pounds of net explosive weight; and

9           WHEREAS, Despite the dangerous nature of his mission, this  
10 valorous Texan performed it with steadfast dedication and skill; he  
11 was often placed in perilous circumstances, and his bravery and  
12 quick thinking helped him to survive ambushes and firefights;  
13 moreover, his work directly reduced the enemy's ability to wage  
14 attacks against a key stronghold while it helped to ensure the  
15 safety of 27,000 Coalition Force soldiers; and

16           WHEREAS, Americans owe an immeasurable debt to Staff Sergeant  
17 Wright and to all our military servicemen and servicewomen, for  
18 they have been called on to bear great, often unimaginable,  
19 burdens, and render sacrifice that is truly beyond measure; and

20           WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Wright's outstanding leadership and  
21 unwavering dedication to his mission exemplify the highest  
22 standards of the United States Armed Forces, and he is truly  
23 deserving of his fellow citizens' deepest respect and gratitude;  
24 now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
2 Legislature hereby commend U.S. Air Force Staff Sergeant Glenn A.  
3 Wright for his outstanding service in Iraq and congratulate him on  
4 earning the Bronze Star; and, be it further

5           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
6 prepared for Staff Sergeant Wright as an expression of high regard  
7 by the Texas House of Representatives.
