2 Borrero has been awarded the Bronze Star for his meritorious  
3 service in Iraq; and

4           WHEREAS, Working as an explosive ordnance disposal craftsman  
5 and team leader, Staff Sergeant Borrero led more than 80 operations  
6 from January through June 2006, helping to excavate, recover, and  
7 destroy improvised explosive devices and weapons caches; and

8           WHEREAS, Despite the dangerous nature of his mission, this  
9 valorous Texan performed it with steadfast dedication and skill,  
10 and his bravery and quick thinking helped him to survive numerous  
11 perilous situations; moreover, his work directly reduced the  
12 enemy's ability to wage attacks against a key stronghold while it  
13 helped to ensure the safety of 16,000 coalition forces; and

14           WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Borrero is also credited with saving  
15 the life of an Iraqi political leader; having the presence of mind  
16 to clear the area of civilians, he was able to disarm an explosive  
17 that would have certainly killed or injured many; and

19 Borrero and to all our military servicemen and servicewomen, for  
20 they have been called on to bear great, often unimaginable,  
21 burdens, and render sacrifice that is truly beyond measure; and
