R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Patrick Simpson Crim of Boy Scouts of America Troop
2 No. 412 in Dallas has attained the rank of Eagle Scout and was
3 awarded the insignia of that grade at his Court of Honor on April
4 28, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, The Eagle Scout badge is a significant honor,
6 bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the scouting
7 movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding criteria,
8 Mr. Crim earned the requisite 21 merit badges and successfully
9 completed an Eagle Scout project; to satisfy the latter
10 requirement, he designed and constructed a 500-square-foot
11 pavestone patio at St. Monica School; and

13 Texan has demonstrated outstanding leadership ability throughout
14 his scouting career, serving as senior patrol leader and winning
15 the respect and admiration of his fellow scouts as he worked toward
16 the highest rank that scouting offers; and

18 where he will begin his senior year in the fall of 2007, Mr. Crim has
19 been a member of the Key Club and the football, track, and JBA
20 basketball teams and has also served as a tutor and as assistant
21 coach of the St. Monica School boys' baseball team; and

22 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Crim's dedication to excellence and his
23 perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to
24 stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride

1 on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

3 Legislature hereby congratulate Patrick Simpson Crim on achieving
4 the rank of Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for
