- 18 complex, and on one memorable occasion, she created the enormous
- 19 "Queen Emilia" cake that fed 600 people; and
- WHEREAS, That cake was made for her son's wedding, and Mrs.
- 21 Hernandez's devotion to her children was shown in countless other
- 22 ways; with the passing years, Mrs. Hernandez welcomed new
- 23 generations to the family, which grew to include 13 grandchildren
- 24 and three great-grandchildren with whom she shared her love and
