6 manager, educational consultant, leadership center creator,

8 her notable resume includes tenures with the California Department

10 programs, and the School of Education at National University of  
11 Sacramento, where she worked as a professor; in addition, she was  
12 principal of Madison Junior High School in Oakland, California, and  
13 was the first African American to serve as a principal in the

16 Washington University holds a bachelor's degree in music, a  
17 master's degree and Ph.D. in administration, and an Ed.D. in  
18 education leadership; she is the recipient of numerous honors,  
19 including two Dale Carnegie Awards, outstanding leader in  
20 elementary and secondary education accolades, and recognition from  
21 Personalities of the South and Who's Who of American Women; and

22           WHEREAS, Although she recently "retired," Dr. Spain can be  
23 found today sharing her passion for learning as an instructor on the  
24 Navajo Reservation in Arizona; she also gives of her time and

1 talents as a member of Optimist International, Phi Delta Kappa  
2 International, and American Educational Research Association; and

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Spain has set a sterling example of leadership  
4 and professional achievement to which all may aspire; she may  
5 reflect with pride on her many years of service to the youth of our  
6 nation, knowing that her efforts have made a positive difference in  
7 the lives of countless individuals; now, therefore, be it
