WHEREAS, A 2005 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point, Travis Atwood is the husband of Terran Atwood of Abilene and the son of Sam and Shirley Atwood of Goliad; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Atwood's outstanding leadership has greatly contributed to the Global War on Terrorism, and his sure and decisive actions during combat operations reflect admirably on the Multinational Division--Baghdad and the United States Army; now, therefore, be it
