1 WHEREAS, Congregants of the Church of God in Christ were
2 deeply saddened by the death of their esteemed leader, Presiding
3 Bishop G. E. Patterson of Memphis, Tennessee, who passed away in
4 March 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in Humboldt, Tennessee, G. E. Patterson
6 attended Lemoyne-Owen College in Memphis and the Detroit Bible
7 Institute and held an honorary doctorate from Oral Roberts
8 University; ordained as an elder in the COGIC in 1957, he served as
9 a minister for nearly 50 years, during which time he organized
10 Temple of Deliverance COGIC in Memphis; and

11 WHEREAS, One of his most notable accomplishments was the
12 founding of Bountiful Blessings Ministries, a worldwide telecast
13 program, through which he reached millions of people with his
14 positive message of faith; he further distinguished himself as the
15 jurisdictional prelate of the Tennessee Fourth Ecclesiastical
16 Jurisdiction and as a member of the COGIC general board, and on
17 November 14, 2000, he was elected presiding bishop; and

18 WHEREAS, Although Bishop Patterson is deeply missed, he
19 leaves behind an inspiring legacy of compassion, hope, and faith
20 that will be forever treasured by all those whose lives he touched;
21 now, therefore, be it
