1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Army Specialist Dominic J. Hinton of
3 Jacksonville, who died while bravely serving his country on
4 November 19, 2005, at the age of 24; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to Company B, 1st Battalion, 187th Infantry
6 Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division,
7 Specialist Hinton was one of four soldiers killed when a roadside
8 bomb detonated near their Humvee during combat operations in Bayji,
9 Iraq; and

10 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
11 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
12 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
13 and gratitude; and

14 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
15 forces, Dominic J. Hinton inspired others with his fortitude,
16 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
17 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
18 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

20 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Specialist Dominic J.
21 Hinton and extend deepest sympathy to all those who mourn his
