R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Marine Lance Corporal Phillip C. George of
3 Houston, who died while bravely serving his country on August 18,
4 2005, at the age of 22; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment,
6 3rd Marine Division, 3rd Marine Expeditionary Force, Lance
7 Corporal George was killed by enemy small-arms fire during combat
8 operations near Taleban, Afghanistan; and

9 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
10 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
11 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
12 and gratitude; and

13 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
14 forces, Phillip C. George inspired others with his fortitude,
15 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
16 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
17 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
19 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Lance
20 Corporal Phillip C. George and extend deepest sympathy to all those
21 who mourn his passing; and, be it further

22 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
23 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of
24 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of U.S.
