R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Army Sergeant Michael C. Taylor of Hockley, who
3 died while bravely serving his country on December 7, 2005, at the
4 age of 23; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to Headquarters Battery, 3rd Battalion,
6 13th Field Artillery, 214th Field Artillery Brigade, 3rd Corps
7 Artillery, Sergeant Taylor was killed when a roadside bomb
8 detonated near his Heavy Expanded Mobility Tactical Truck while his
9 unit was conducting combat operations in Balad, Iraq; and

10 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
11 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
12 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
13 and gratitude; and

14 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
15 forces, Michael C. Taylor inspired others with his fortitude,
16 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
17 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
18 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it
