1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Air Force Technical Sergeant Walter M. Moss,
3 Jr., of Houston, who died while bravely serving his country on March
4 29, 2006, at the age of 37; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 366th Civil Engineer Squadron, 366th
6 Mission Support Group, Technical Sergeant Moss was killed when a
7 bomb exploded during operations near Baghdad, Iraq; and

8 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
9 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
10 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
11 and gratitude; and

12 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
13 forces, Walter M. Moss, Jr., inspired others with his fortitude,
14 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
15 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
16 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

18 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Technical
19 Sergeant Walter M. Moss, Jr., and extend deepest sympathy to all
