R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Jerry M. Durbin, Jr., of
3 Spring, who died while bravely serving his country on January 25,
4 2006, at the age of 26; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 502nd Infantry
6 Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division, Staff
7 Sergeant Durbin was killed when a roadside bomb detonated near his
8 dismounted patrol during combat operations in Baghdad, Iraq; and

9 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
10 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
11 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
12 and gratitude; and

13 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
14 forces, Jerry M. Durbin, Jr., inspired others with his fortitude,
15 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
16 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
17 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
19 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Staff Sergeant Jerry
20 M. Durbin, Jr., and extend deepest sympathy to all those who mourn
21 his passing; and, be it further

24 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of U.S.
