R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt  
2 at the loss of U.S. Army Specialist J. Adan Garcia of Irving, who  
3 died while bravely serving his country on May 27, 2006, at the age  
4 of 20; and

5           WHEREAS, Assigned to Company A, 1st Brigade Special Troops  
6 Battalion, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division,  
7 Specialist Garcia was mortally wounded when his convoy encountered  
8 small-arms fire as it was returning from an explosive ordnance  
9 mission; and

10           WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's  
11 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous  
12 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect  
13 and gratitude; and

14           WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed  
15 forces, J. Adan Garcia inspired others with his fortitude,  
16 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives  
17 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic  
18 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

20 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Specialist J. Adan  
21 Garcia and extend deepest sympathy to all those who mourn his
