R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Army First Lieutenant Benjamin T. Britt of
3 Wheeler, who died while bravely serving his country on December 22,
4 2005, at the age of 24; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to Company B, 1st Battalion, 502nd Infantry
6 Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division, First
7 Lieutenant Britt was one of two soldiers killed when a bomb
8 detonated near their position during a dismounted patrol in
9 Baghdad, Iraq; and

10 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
11 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
12 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
13 and gratitude; and

14 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
15 forces, Benjamin T. Britt inspired others with his fortitude,
16 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
17 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
18 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

20 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of First
21 Lieutenant Benjamin T. Britt and extend deepest sympathy to all
