R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Army Corporal Jason B. Daniel of Fort Worth, who
3 died while bravely serving his country on April 23, 2006, at the age
4 of 21; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to C Troop, 7th Squadron, 10th Cavalry
6 Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division,
7 Corporal Daniel was one of three soldiers killed when a roadside
8 bomb detonated near their Humvee during combat operations in Taji,
9 Iraq; and

10 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
11 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
12 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
13 and gratitude; and

14 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
15 forces, Jason B. Daniel inspired others with his fortitude,
16 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
17 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
18 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

20 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Corporal Jason B.
21 Daniel and extend deepest sympathy to all those who mourn his
