R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Francis E. Bartley is graduating from Texas State  
2 University-San Marcos in May 2007, and during his impressive  
3 academic career he served the TSU System as its first student regent  
4 and as a legislative intern; and

5           WHEREAS, Appointed to the TSU System Board of Regents by  
6 Governor Rick Perry in February 2006, Mr. Bartley worked to ensure  
7 that the wants and needs of his fellow students were heard and  
8 addressed; he continued in his service to the TSU System as a  
9 legislative intern in the Office of Governmental Relations during  
10 the 80th Texas Legislature, where he demonstrated professionalism  
11 and invaluable insight; and

12           WHEREAS, Mr. Bartley graduates with a major in public  
13 administration and a minor in economics; throughout his career at  
14 TSU, he supported himself with part-time jobs and participated in a  
15 number of student organizations; the founder and president of The  
16 Loud Crowd, he also served as president of the Freshman Class  
17 Council and as secretary-treasurer of the American Red Cross Club;

21 serving as a volunteer with Habitat for Humanity and the Relay For

24 Public Administration; and

2 academic achievement, to his fellow students, and to the greater  
3 community, and Texas is fortunate to have benefited from the hard  
4 work and dedication of this outstanding young man; now, therefore,
