1 WHEREAS, The year 2007 marks the 25th anniversary of the
2 founding of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Longview; and

3 WHEREAS, St. Mary's was built in an effort to meet the needs
4 of Longview's Catholic community, which had outgrown its old
5 downtown church, and in 1982 St. Mary's Parish was formed under the
6 leadership of Bishop Thomas Tschoepe; and

7 WHEREAS, Monsignor John A. Brennan served as the first pastor
8 of St. Mary's, which is ably led today by the Reverend Gavin
9 Vavarek; now a part of the Diocese of Tyler under Bishop Charles F.
10 Herzig, the church has grown to include a school, sports center,
11 rosary garden with sitting area, labyrinth, walking trail through
12 the piney woods, and 24-hour chapel; and

13 WHEREAS, Outreach remains a priority for the institution,
14 which hosts such events as the annual Stampede Race and Fun Run,
15 Monsignor Shopka Golf Tournament, Wunderfall celebration, and the
16 annual basketball free throw competition of the Knights of
17 Columbus; and

18 WHEREAS, From its beginnings, St. Mary's has served as a
19 source of fellowship, comfort, and guidance to its members while
20 also ministering to the needs of its community, and the
21 congregation's rich and dynamic history is indeed deserving of
22 special recognition; now, therefore, be it
