professional community as the superintendent of the Raven Charter 15 School and as a staff representative for the Marine Engineers 16

Beneficial Association, the PCD, the AFL-CIO, and the Office

18 Employees International Union; and

WHEREAS, In addition, this notable Texan gave generously of 19 his time and talents as a board member of Texas Education Agency 20 21 Region 6, the Walker County Chamber of Commerce, the Texas 22 Youth-Build Coalition, New Leader's Academy, and the National Youth 23 Employment Coalition; his efforts earned him several awards, 24 including the first Bridge Builders Annual Award and the New
