1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the heartache felt
2 at the loss of U.S. Army Specialist Lance C. Springer III of Fort
3 Worth, who died while bravely serving his country on March 23, 2007,
4 at the age of 23; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Squadron, 40th Cavalry Regiment,
6 4th Airborne Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division,
7 Specialist Springer was mortally wounded when an improvised
8 explosive device detonated near his unit while on combat patrol in
9 Baghdad, Iraq; and

10 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to our nation's
11 servicemen and servicewomen, whose courageous efforts and enormous
12 sacrifices are deserving of their fellow citizens' deepest respect
13 and gratitude; and

14 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
15 forces, Lance C. Springer III inspired others with his fortitude,
16 tenacity, and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives
17 of his loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic
18 Texan close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
20 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Specialist Lance C.
21 Springer III and extend deepest sympathy to all those who mourn his
22 passing; and, be it further
