

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Frances R. Anderson is a native of Georgetown,  
2 Guyana (British Guiana), South America; and

3           WHEREAS, Mrs. Anderson is a graduate of Tuskegee University,  
4 Alabama (BS); she furthered her studies at Lincoln University and  
5 East Texas State University, and Texas A&M University at Commerce;  
6 and

7           WHEREAS, She has earned the distinguished lifetime  
8 certificate in elementary and secondary education; and

9           WHEREAS, Her 30-year teaching career includes a 22-year  
10 tenure in Terrell; and

11           WHEREAS, Mrs. Anderson's community involvement is paramount;  
12 her community experience includes a 17-year tenure as a city  
13 council member of the City of Terrell, and she has served as mayor  
14 pro tem, board member of the Kaufman County Appraisal District,  
15 vice president-director of the Terrell Economic Development  
16 Corporation, board member of the Terrell Alliance of Education and  
17 the Arts and been involved with the Southwestern Christian College  
18 in the restoration of a historically designated building (Robert A.  
19 Terrell Roundhouse); and

20           WHEREAS, In June 2002 she became mayor of Terrell and was  
21 reelected to a second term in June 2004; and

22           WHEREAS, Under the mayoral leadership of Frances R. Anderson,  
23 the city of Terrell is positioned as a leader in Kaufman County; and

24           WHEREAS, Mayor Anderson and the team of her colleagues on the

1 city council have adopted several ordinances and resolutions to  
2 improve the quality of life for all citizens of Terrell; and

3 WHEREAS, Mayor Anderson has established stronger code  
4 enforcement and development standards while improving the city's  
5 infrastructure, water system, streets, and drainage; and

6 WHEREAS, After 22 years of service as council member and  
7 mayor, the State of Texas will hold Mayor Anderson as a model for  
8 community service and leadership; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
10 Legislature recognize Mayor Frances R. Anderson for her  
11 contribution in building a better Terrell; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
13 prepared for Mayor Anderson as an expression of high regard by the  
14 Texas House of Representatives.
