R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Frances R. Anderson, is a native of Georgetown,
2 Guyana (British Guiana) South America; and

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Anderson is a graduate of Tuskegee University,
4 Alabama (BS), she furthered her studies at Lincoln University and
5 East Texas State University, Texas A&M at Commerce, Texas; and

6 WHEREAS, She has earned the distinguished lifetime
7 certificate in elementary and secondary education; and

8 WHEREAS, over the course of her 30 year teaching career,
9 22-year tenure in Terrell, Texas; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Anderson's Community involvement is paramount,
11 her community experience includes a 17-year tenure as City Council
12 Member City of Terrell, and served as Mayor Pro Tem, Board
13 member-Kaufman County Appraisal District, Vice President-Director
14 of Terrell Economic Development Corporation, Board member-Terrell
15 Alliance of Education and the Arts, and involved with the
16 Southwestern Christian College in the restoration of an
17 Historically Designated Building (Robert A. Terrell Roundhouse);

19 WHEREAS, In June 2002, became Mayor of Terrell, Texas
20 re-elected to a second term in June 2004; and

21 WHEREAS, Under the Mayoral leadership of Frances R. Anderson,
22 the City of Terrell is positioned as a leader in Kaufman County; and

24 City Council have adopted several ordinances and resolutions to

2 WHEREAS, Mayor Anderson has established stronger Code
3 Enforcement and Development standards while improving the City's
4 infrastructure, water system, streets and drainage; and

6 and Mayor, the State of Texas will hold Mayor Anderson as a model
7 for Community Service and Leadership; now, therefore, be it
