1 WHEREAS, John Matthews, a senior at Ross S. Sterling High
2 School in Baytown, brought home a Class 5A state crown with an
3 inspiring performance in the 300-meter hurdles at the University
4 Interscholastic League 2007 Track State Championships in Austin;

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Matthews captured the state title with a time of
7 36.34 seconds, capping a two-year unbeaten streak in his signature
8 event; the young track star also placed second in the 110-meter
9 hurdles and anchored the mile relay team, which finished third; and

10 WHEREAS, With his strong performance at the 2007 state meet,
11 Mr. Matthews helped steer Sterling High School to a fourth-place
12 finish in the team competition; the Rangers' 30-point total is the
13 most ever scored by a team from Sterling High School, a proud
14 accomplishment for each of the school's track athletes; and

15 WHEREAS, Winning a state championship represents the
16 culmination of hours of hard work and preparation, and John
17 Matthews will undoubtedly remember this significant achievement
18 for years to come; now, therefore, be it
