R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Austin attorney E. Eugene Palmer has long been a
2 valued member of the legal profession in the Lone Star State, and
3 his expertise and dedication have earned him the respect and
4 admiration of many people over the course of his outstanding
5 career; and

6 WHEREAS, Born June 19, 1931, in San Antonio, Mr. Palmer
7 answered his nation's call to duty as a young man, serving in the
8 United States Army from 1952 to 1954; he received his undergraduate
9 degree from Southern Methodist University in 1956, and he is a 1958
10 graduate of The University of Texas School of Law; and

11 WHEREAS, Admitted to the bar in 1957, Mr. Palmer has been
12 licensed to practice before the Supreme Court of Texas, the United
13 States Supreme Court, the Fifth and Eleventh Circuits of the U.S.
14 Court of Appeals, and all four districts of the U.S. District Courts
15 in Texas; board certified in administrative law by the Texas Board
16 of Legal Specialization, Mr. Palmer is also a certified arbitrator
17 for the Western District of the U.S. District Court; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Palmer's practice encompasses such diverse
19 areas of expertise as administrative law, legislation, insurance
20 law, alcoholic beverage control, gaming law, and professional
21 licensing regulation; his active engagement with his profession
22 includes membership in the State Bar of Texas, the Austin Bar
23 Association, and the American Bar Association; and

24 WHEREAS, For 50 years, Mr. Palmer has distinguished himself

1 in his chosen field of law, and he may indeed reflect with pride on
2 his many professional achievements and the exceptional service that
3 he has provided to his clients; now, therefore, be it
