1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, That House Rule 13,
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on House Bill 2833 (the licensing and
6 regulation of certain private security services) to consider and
7 take action on the following matter:

8 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit the
9 committee to change the text of SECTION 5 of the bill by
10 substituting Paragraph (C), Subdivision (2), Subsection (c),
11 Section 1702.113, Occupations Code, to read as follows:

12 (C) provides as a possible punishment
13 confinement in a jail other than a state jail felony facility; or

14 Explanation: The change is necessary to correct a
15 grammatical error.

16 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit the
17 committee to change the text of SECTION 5 of the bill by
18 substituting Paragraph (C), Subdivision (3), Subsection (c),
19 Section 1702.113, Occupations Code, to read as follows:

20 (C) provides as a possible punishment
21 confinement in a jail other than a state jail felony facility; or
