# RESOLUTION

2 the 2007 University Interscholastic League Class 3A State Golf  
3 Championship with a dominating performance in the two-day event  
4 held on May 10 and 11; and

5 WHEREAS, Coach Randy Mann, who has been at the helm of the  
6 Medina Valley golf program for seven years, watched proudly as his  
7 young charges captured the district and regional championships on  
8 their way to winning the team's first state championship by an  
9 impressive margin of nine strokes; and

10 WHEREAS, The Panthers led by seven strokes at the end of the  
11 first day, posting a solid score of 292, and the team finished day  
12 two at 304 to card a cumulative total of 596; and

13 WHEREAS, Freshman Curtis Reed led the team with a two-day  
14 total of 145 and claimed the individual title after winning with a  
15 birdie on the fifth playoff hole; teammates Ben Chambers, Josh  
16 Hart, and Stanton Tondre tallied two-day totals of 151 to tie for  
17 fourth place, while Kyle Emerson finished one stroke back in a  
18 fifth-place tie; alternate Randall Rodgers also made vital  
19 contributions to the team's success throughout the season; and

20 WHEREAS, Winning a state championship is the ultimate  
21 achievement for high school athletes and represents the culmination  
22 of countless hours of hard work and preparation, and the memory of  
23 this significant achievement will remain with these young men for  
24 years to come; now, therefore, be it
