A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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AN ACT

2 relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, the 3 availability and use of automated external defibrillators at certain school campuses and athletic events, and the creation of a 4 5 cardiovascular screening pilot program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 5.001, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subdivision (6-a) to read as follows: 8

(6-a) "Private school" means a school that: 9 (A) offers a course of instruction for students 10 11 in one or more grades from prekindergarten through grade 12; and 12 (B) is not operated by a governmental entity. 13 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 7.026, Education Code,

14 is amended to read as follows:

The agency may accept donations, including donations of 15 (a) equipment, for use in providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation 16 (CPR) instruction to students. The agency: 17

shall distribute the donations to school districts 18 (1)for the purpose of providing [that provide] CPR instruction to 19 students under Sections 28.0023 and [Section] 29.903; and 20

21 (2) may use a portion of the donations to the extent 22 necessary to pay administrative expenses related to the donations. 23 SECTION 3. Subchapter Z, Chapter 22, Education Code, is

amended by adding Section 22.902 to read as follows: 24

1	Sec. 22.902. INSTRUCTION RELATED TO CARDIOPULMONARY
2	RESUSCITATION AND USE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR. (a) A
3	school district shall annually make available to district employees
4	and volunteers instruction in the principles and techniques of
5	cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external
6	defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety
7	Code.
8	(b) The instruction provided in the use of an automated
9	external defibrillator must meet guidelines for automated external
10	defibrillator training approved under Section 779.002, Health and
11	Safety Code.
12	(c) Each school nurse, assistant school nurse, athletic
13	coach or sponsor, physical education instructor, marching band
14	director, cheerleading coach, and any other school employee
15	specified by the commissioner and each student who serves as an
16	athletic trainer must participate in the instruction in the use of
17	an automated external defibrillator. A person described by this
18	subsection must receive and maintain certification in the use of an
19	automated external defibrillator from the American Heart
20	Association, the American Red Cross, or a similar nationally
21	recognized association.
22	(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
23	implement this section.
24	(e) This subsection applies only to a private school that
25	receives an automated external defibrillator from the agency or
26	receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an automated
27	external defibrillator. A private school shall adopt a policy

1	under which the school makes available to school employees and
2	volunteers instruction in the principles and techniques of
3	cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external
4	defibrillator. The policy must comply with the requirements
5	prescribed by this section and commissioner rules adopted under
6	this section, including the requirements prescribed by Subsection
7	<u>(c).</u>
8	SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
9	amended by adding Section 28.0023 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 28.0023. CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND AUTOMATED
11	EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR INSTRUCTION. (a) In this section,
12	"automated external defibrillator" has the meaning assigned by
13	Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code.
14	(b) The State Board of Education by rule shall include
15	elements relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation
16	and the use of an automated external defibrillator as part of the
17	essential knowledge and skills of the health curriculum under
18	Section 28.002(a)(2)(B).
19	(c) This subsection applies only to a private school that
20	receives an automated external defibrillator from the agency or
21	receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an automated
22	external defibrillator. A private school shall provide instruction
23	to students in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an
24	automated external defibrillator in a manner consistent with the
25	requirements of this section and State Board of Education rules
26	adopted under this section.
27	SECTION 5. Subsection (a), Section 29.903, Education Code,

1 is amended to read as follows:

school district [that provides instruction to 2 (a) А students in the principles and techniques of cardiopulmonary 3 resuscitation (CPR)] may accept from the agency donations the 4 agency receives under Section 7.026 for [. The district must] use 5 6 [those donations] in providing instruction to students in the 7 principles and techniques of CPR. A district may accept other 8 donations, including donations of equipment, for use in providing 9 the instruction.

10 SECTION 6. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is 11 amended by adding Sections 38.017, 38.018, and 38.019 to read as 12 follows:

Sec. 38.017. AVAILABILITY OF AUTOMATED 13 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR. (a) Each school district shall make available at 14 15 each campus in the district at least one automated external defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety 16 17 Code. A campus defibrillator must be readily available during any University Interscholastic League athletic competition held on the 18 19 campus. In determining the location at which to store a campus defibrillator, the principal of the campus shall consider the 20 21 primary location on campus where students engage in athletic 22 activities.

(b) To the extent practicable, each school district, in
 cooperation with the University Interscholastic League, shall make
 reasonable efforts to ensure that an automated external
 defibrillator is available at each University Interscholastic
 League athletic practice held at a district campus. If a school

district is not able to make an automated external defibrillator 1 2 available in the manner provided by this subsection, the district shall determine the extent to which an automated external 3 4 defibrillator must be available at each University Interscholastic League athletic practice held at a district campus. 5 The 6 determination must be based, in addition to any other appropriate 7 considerations, on relevant medical information. (c) Each school district, in cooperation with the 8 University Interscholastic League, shall determine the extent to 9 which an automated external defibrillator must be available at each 10 University Interscholastic League athletic competition held at a 11

12 location other than a district campus. The determination must be 13 based, in addition to any other appropriate considerations, on 14 relevant medical information and whether emergency services 15 personnel are present at the athletic competition under a contract 16 with the school district.

17 (d) Each school district shall ensure the presence at each 18 location at which an automated external defibrillator is required 19 under Subsection (a), (b), or (c) of at least one campus or district 20 employee trained in the proper use of the defibrillator at any time 21 a substantial number of district students are present at the 22 location.

23 (e) A school district shall ensure that an automated 24 external defibrillator is used and maintained in accordance with 25 standards established under Chapter 779, Health and Safety Code. 26 (f) This section does not:

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(1) waive any liability or immunity of a school

1	district or its officers or employees; or
2	(2) create any liability for or a cause of action
3	against a school district or its officers or employees.
4	(g) This subsection applies only to a private school that
5	receives an automated external defibrillator from the agency or
6	receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an automated
7	external defibrillator. A private school shall:
8	(1) make available at the school at least one
9	automated external defibrillator; and
10	(2) in coordination with the Texas Association of
11	Private and Parochial Schools, adopt a policy concerning the
12	availability of an automated external defibrillator at athletic
13	competitions and practices in a manner consistent with the
14	requirements prescribed by this section, including the training and
15	maintenance requirements prescribed by this section.
16	Sec. 38.018. PROCEDURES REGARDING RESPONSE TO CARDIAC
17	ARREST. (a) Each school district and private school shall develop
18	safety procedures for a district or school employee or student to
19	follow in responding to a medical emergency involving cardiac
20	arrest, including the appropriate response time in administering
21	cardiopulmonary resuscitation, using an automated external
22	defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety
23	Code, or calling a local emergency medical services provider.
24	(b) A private school is required to develop safety
25	procedures under this section only if the school receives an
26	automated external defibrillator from the agency or receives
27	funding from the agency to purchase or lease an automated external

1 defibrillator.

2 Sec. 38.019. CARDIOVASCULAR SCREENING PILOT PROGRAM.
3 (a) In this section, "pilot program" means the cardiovascular
4 screening pilot program.
5 (b) The commissioner shall establish a pilot program under

6 which sixth grade students at participating campuses are
 7 administered a cardiovascular screening, including an
 8 electrocardiogram and an echocardiogram.

9 <u>(c) The commissioner shall select campuses to participate</u> 10 <u>in the pilot program. In selecting campuses, the commissioner</u> 11 <u>shall ensure that the cardiovascular screening is administered to</u> 12 <u>an ethnically diverse range of students.</u>

13 (d) The commissioner may accept grants and donations for use 14 in administering the pilot program.

15 (e) The commissioner shall require a participating campus 16 to provide the results of a student's cardiovascular screening to 17 the student's parent or guardian.

18 (f) Each campus selected to participate in the pilot program 19 shall provide a summary of the results of the cardiovascular 20 screenings to the commissioner in a manner that does not identify 21 specific students. Not later than January 1, 2009, the 22 commissioner shall prepare and deliver to each member of the 23 legislature a report summarizing the results of the cardiovascular 24 screenings. This subsection expires June 1, 2009.

25 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to 26 administer this section.

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SECTION 7. Subchapter B, Chapter 44, Education Code, is

1 amended by adding Section 44.047 to read as follows: 2 Sec. 44.047. PURCHASE OR LEASE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR. (a) A school district or private school that 3 purchases or leases an automated external defibrillator, as defined 4 by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, shall ensure that the 5 6 automated external defibrillator meets standards established by 7 the federal Food and Drug Administration. (b) A private school that purchases or leases an automated 8 9 external defibrillator is required to comply with the requirements of this section only if the school receives funding from the agency 10

11 to purchase or lease the automated external defibrillator.

SECTION 8. Subsection (b), Section 29.903, Education Code, is repealed.

SECTION 9. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.

(b) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules relating 16 17 to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator in accordance with Section 18 28.0023, Education Code, as added by this Act, not later than March 19 1, 2008. The rules shall require each school district and 20 21 open-enrollment charter school to provide instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external 22 defibrillator beginning with the 2008-2009 school year. 23

(c) Each private school to which Subsection (c), Section
28.0023, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies shall
provide instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of
an automated external defibrillator as required by that section

1 beginning with the 2008-2009 school year.

2 (d) The State Board of Education is not required to review 3 and adopt textbooks for the health curriculum to comply with the 4 requirements of Section 28.0023, Education Code, as added by this 5 Act, until those textbooks are otherwise scheduled for review and 6 adoption under the cycle adopted under Section 31.022, Education 7 Code.

8 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it 9 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 10 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 11 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 12 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
