A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the imposition of additional inspection and background 3 and criminal history check requirements for day-care centers. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 42.044, Human Resources Code, is amended 5 by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 6 (b-1) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, 7 8 during an unannounced annual inspection of a day-care center, the department shall meet with the director designated by the day-care 9 center as having daily, on-site responsibility for the operation of 10 the day-care center to assess whether the director meets the 11 12 qualifications of a director specified by this chapter and 13 department rules. If the director is not present during the unannounced annual inspection, the department shall schedule a 14 subsequent meeting with the director for that purpose and shall 15 conduct that meeting at the day-care center. 16 SECTION 2. Section 42.056, Human Resources Code, is amended 17 18 by adding Subsections (a-2), (b-1), and (g) to read as follows: (a-2) In accordance with rules adopted by the executive 19 commissioner, the director, owner, or operator of a day-care center 20 21 shall submit a complete set of fingerprints of each person whose name is submitted by the director, owner, or operator under 22 23 Subsection (a). The rules adopted by the executive commissioner must require that the fingerprints be submitted in a form and of a 24

1	quality acceptable to the Department of Public Safety and the
2	Federal Bureau of Investigation for conducting a criminal history
3	check.
4	(b-1) In addition to any other background or criminal
5	history check conducted under Subsection (b), for each person whose
6	name is submitted by the director, owner, or operator of a day-care
7	center under Subsection (a), the department shall conduct a state
8	and Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history check by:
9	(1) submitting the person's fingerprints provided
10	under Subsection (a-2) to the Department of Public Safety for the
11	purpose of conducting a state and federal criminal history check;
12	and
13	(2) using the resulting information made available by
14	that department under Section 411.114, Government Code, and by the
15	Federal Bureau of Investigation and any other criminal justice
16	agency under Section 411.087, Government Code.

(g) A person whose name is submitted by the director, owner, 17 or operator of a day-care center under Subsection (a) may not 18 provide direct care or have direct access to a child in a day-care 19 20 center before the person's background and criminal history checks under Subsections (b) and (b-1) are completed. 21

22 SECTION 3. Section 42.056, Human Resources Code, as amended by this Act, applies to the conduct of background and criminal 23 24 history checks of a person whose name is submitted to the Department of Family and Protective Services under Section 42.056(a), Human 25 Resources Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. 26 27

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
