A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to a pilot program to educate residents and families of

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. ADVANCE CARE PLANNING PILOT PROGRAM. (a) The
- 7 Department of Aging and Disability Services shall develop and
- 8 implement a pilot program to increase the use of advance directives
- 9 by residents of nursing homes and intermediate care facilities for
- 10 the mentally retarded in this state by educating the residents and
- 11 the families of residents about advance care planning.
- 12 (b) The pilot program shall provide for a process to educate
- 13 residents and the families of residents regarding:
- 14 (1) the legal issues associated with advance
- 15 directives;
- 16 (2) the health care choices available to a person with
- 17 a terminal or irreversible condition;
- 18 (3) the proper completion of advance directives; and
- 19 (4) the importance of discussing advance directives
- 20 with family, friends, advisers, and health care providers.
- 21 SECTION 2. RULES. The executive commissioner of the Health
- 22 and Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement this
- 23 Act.
- SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than October 1, 2010, the

- 1 Department of Aging and Disability Services shall submit a report
- 2 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
- 3 of representatives, and the appropriate standing committees of the
- 4 legislature, regarding the pilot program that includes:
- 5 (1) an evaluation of the effectiveness of the pilot
- 6 program; and
- 7 (2) a recommendation to continue, expand, or eliminate
- 8 the pilot program.
- 9 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2011.
- 10 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 12 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 13 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
