- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. ADVANCE CARE PLANNING PILOT PROGRAM. (a) The
- 6 Department of Aging and Disability Services shall develop and
- 7 implement a pilot program to increase the use of advance directives
- 8 by nursing home residents in this state by educating the residents
- 9 about advance care planning.
- 10 (b) The pilot program shall provide for a process to educate
- 11 nursing home residents regarding:
- 12 (1) the legal issues associated with advance
- 13 directives;
- 14 (2) the health care choices available to a person with
- 15 a terminal or irreversible condition;
- 16 (3) the proper completion of advance directives; and
- 17 (4) the importance of discussing advance directives
- 18 with family, friends, advisers, and health care providers.
- 19 SECTION 2. RULES. The executive commissioner of the Health
- 20 and Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement this
- 21 Act.
- SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than October 1, 2010, the
- 23 Department of Aging and Disability Services shall submit a report
- 24 to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of

- 1 representatives, and the appropriate standing committees of the
- 2 legislature, regarding the pilot program that includes:
- 3 (1) an evaluation of the effectiveness of the pilot
- 4 program; and
- 5 (2) a recommendation to continue, expand, or eliminate
- 6 the pilot program.
- 7 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2011.
- 8 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 9 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 10 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 11 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
