A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of a minimum data set for the collection of
3	information on health professionals by the statewide health
4	coordinating council.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 105.003, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (c-1),
8	(c-2), (f), (g), and (h) to read as follows:
9	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (h), the Department of
10	Information Resources, through TexasOnline and in consultation
11	with the council and the Health Professions Council, shall add and
12	label as "mandatory" the following fields on an application or
13	renewal form for a license, certificate, or registration for a
14	person regulated by a health occupation regulatory agency that is a
15	member of the Health Professions Council and for emergency medical
16	services personnel regulated by the Department of State Health
17	Services:
18	(1) full name and last four digits of social security
19	number;
20	(2) certification, registration, or licensure
21	information, including certification, registration, or license
22	number, issuance date, method of certification, registration, or
23	licensure, and certification, registration, or licensure status;
24	(3) full mailing address; and

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(4) educational background and training, including basic health professions degree, school name and location of basic health professions degree, and graduation year for basic health professions degree, and, as applicable, highest professional degree obtained, related professional school name and location, and related graduation year [At a minimum, the data collected by the council must include the following in regard to health

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8 professionals:

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[(1) their number and geographic distribution;

[(2) licensure or certification status;

- 11 [(3) specialty areas, if applicable; and
- 12 [(4) trends or changes in license holders according to 13 number or geographic distribution].
- (c-1) Except as provided by Subsection (h), the Department 14 of Information Resources, through TexasOnline and in consultation 15 16 with the council and the Health Professions Council, shall add and 17 label as "voluntary" the following fields on an application or renewal form for a license, certificate, or registration for a 18 person regulated by a health occupation regulatory agency that is a 19 member of the Health Professions Council and for emergency medical 20 services personnel regulated by the Department of State Health 21 22 Services: (1) date and place of birth; 23 (2) sex; 24
- 25 (3) race and ethnicity;
- 26 (4) location of high school;
- 27 (5) mailing address of primary practice;

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1	(6) number of hours per week spent at primary practice
2	<pre>location;</pre>
3	(7) description of primary practice setting;
4	(8) primary practice information, including primary
5	specialty practice, practice location zip code, and county federal
6	information processing standards code; and
7	(9) secondary practice information, including
8	practice location zip code and county federal information
9	processing standards code.
10	(c-2) The members of the Health Professions Council shall
11	encourage each person licensed, certified, or registered under that
12	council's authority to submit application and renewal information
13	under Subsections (c) and (c-1) through the system developed by the
14	Department of Information Resources and TexasOnline.
15	(f) The relevant members of the Health Professions Council,
16	in conjunction with the Department of Information Resources, shall
17	ensure that the information collected under Subsections (c) and
18	(c-1) is transmitted to the statewide health coordinating council.
19	The council shall store the information as needed and conduct
20	related workforce studies, including a determination of the
21	geographical distribution of the reporting professionals.
22	(g) The Department of Information Resources shall work with
23	the health occupation regulatory agencies that are members of the
24	Health Professions Council to minimize the costs to Health
25	Professions Council members of obtaining the information under
26	Subsections (c) and (c-1).
27	(h) This section does not apply to the State Board of

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1	Veterinary	Medical	Examiners	or	the	Texas	Funeral	Service

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect March 1, 2008.
