- 7 [(1) their number and geographic distribution;
- 8 [(2) licensure or certification status;
- 9 [(3) specialty areas, if applicable; and
- 10 [(4) trends or changes in license holders according to

- (f) A state board, agency, or association that certifies,
- 13 registers, or licenses a health professional in this state shall
- 14 collect on behalf of the council the information required by the
- 15 <u>minimum data set established under Subsection (c). The council and</u>
- 16 <u>a state board, agency, or association that collects data on behalf</u>
- of the council may enter into an interagency contract regarding the
- 18 data collection.
