3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 105, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 105.009 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 105.009. REGISTRY OF ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS. (a)
7	The council shall establish a registry for all allied health
8	professionals containing information to be used for health
9	workforce studies.
10	(b) The registry shall include the following information
11	about each allied health professional:
12	(1) educational background;
13	(2) profession;
14	(3) specialty, if any;
15	(4) place of practice; and
16	(5) full-time or part-time employment status.
17	(c) A state board, agency, or association that certifies,
18	registers, or licenses a health professional in this state shall
19	collect on behalf of the council the information required under
20	Subsection (b). The council and a state board, agency, or
21	association that collects data on behalf of the council may enter
22	into an interagency contract regarding the data collection.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
